- 2) Who made you? God made me.
- 3) Why did He make you? **To show His goodness and to make me happy with Him in heaven.**
- 4) What must you do to be happy with God in heaven? I must know Him, love Him, and serve Him in this world.
- 5) Where is God? God is everywhere.
- 6) Does God know all things? **Yes, God knows all things the past, present, and future.**
- 7) Can God do all things? Yes, God can do all things.
- 8) Did God have a beginning? **No, God had no beginning. He always was and will always be.**
- 9) How many Gods are there? **There is only one God.**
- 10) How many Persons are there in God? In God there are three Persons the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost
